From beginners to the advanced, players will practice the basic techniques and tactics they need to progress to the next level of skill. Players will be grouped according to age and ability. They will receive both individual and team instruction on the fundamentals of soccer.

**Session One:** At Dearborn Gymnasium, June 23-27, 9:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., ages 5-7, \$50.

**Session Two:** At Dearborn Gymnasium and Prescott Field, June 23-27, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., ages 7-15, \$125.

**Coaches:** Former UMF men's soccer coach and standout student-athlete Jamie Beaudoin is the director for the camp. The camp's instructional staff includes collegiate and high school coaches and players.

**Location:** The camp will be held at Prescott Fields, home of the UMF men's and women's soccer teams, Dearborn Gymnasium and the Fitness and Recreation Center.

I accept and assume the full responsibility for all harm and injury, of every nature, including death, which may occur to me or which I may suffer or cause others, and for all damages or loss to any personal property owned by me or damaged by me, while I am participating in the Camp and during all travel and transportation, and, in furtherance thereof, I agree to indemnify, hold harmless and release the University, its Trustees, faculty, employees, volunteers and agents, from and against any and all claims, demands, actions or causes of action, on account of damage or loss to my personal property, personal injury or death, or the bodily injury, death or damage to personal property of others caused by me which may occur or result directly or indirectly from my participation in the Camp and not as a direct result of any negligent act of the University, its Trustees, faculty, employees, volunteers or agents.

4. I declare that I am able to physically withstand and cope with the indicated rigors of the Camp with or without a reasonable accommodation. If an accommodation is needed, I will contact camp director Jamie Beaudoin at (207) 778-8168.

5. This "Release And Assumption of Risk" shall be construed and interpreted pursuant to the laws of the State of Maine, and if any portion thereof is held invalid, void, unenforceable or illegal, the remainder shall continue in full force and effect.
